From Your Pastor: MEMBERSHIP EXPECTATIONS



**LANCASTER BAPTIST IS A COMMUNITY OF GRACE THAT SEEKS TO GLORIFY GOD. GROW IN CHRIST. AND GO OUT WITH THE GOSPEL.**

It has been a few years since we have talked about the mission statement at Lancaster Baptist. Lancaster Baptist is a community of grace that seeks to glorify God (in and through worship and service), grow in Christ (through discipleship and spiritual disciplines), and go out with the Gospel (through evangelism and missions). We refer to our mission by the 4G's: *Grace, Glorify, Grow, and Go.*

We are brought together as a family through the *grace* of God. Our first objective is to *glorify* God through our worship and our service unto God. As such, we ask our members to make Sunday AM worship a priority and we ask our members to participate in at least 1 ministry of the church (KidZRock, Upward, DNow, Nursery, VBS, Choir, Greeter, Mentor, Prayer ministry, be on a team, or another area of service.)

We want our members to be *growing* in their relationship with Christ through discipleship and spiritual disciplines. We ask our members to be involved in at least one small group Bible study (Sunday School or a Life Group) and to commit to daily Bible reading and prayer. We have Sunday School classes and Life Groups for all ages and at various times. We also have various men and women groups meeting to help us grow spiritually and to provide some helpful accountability. It is so important that we are daily in the Word and in God's presence.

Finally, we want a church that is *going* out with the gospel. We ask our members to participate on the GROW team that represents the area in which you live and to be intentional about sharing your faith on a regular basis. We also ask our members to be involved in at least 1 outreach ministry/mission each year. We have short-term mission trips, neighborhood outreaches, and special events like our annual Thanksgiving meal in which you can participate. We want to be sharing the Gospel in Lancaster, Garrard County, and to the ends of the earth.

Christianity isn't a spectator sport. We want to help you be a faithful Great Commission Christian for the glory of God. How are you doing in these 4 areas?
