### Revelation 11

**Opening Discussion Question:** We are about halfway through Revelation. Do you think that humanity has been warned enough about the coming judgment of God? What do you think it will take for people to turn from their sins and trust in Christ?

Read Revelation 11:1-19

Review/Discuss sermon outline: "Those Two Witnesses"

1) Do you think the events of the tribulation can occur before there is a temple built in Jerusalem? What are your thoughts about the plans for a temple and the issue of the Rock of the Dome being on the current temple mount?

2) Daniel's prophecy speaks of a covenant that Antichrist will make with the Jews (Daniel 9:27) in which it is believed that he will allow the temple to be rebuilt. However, after 3 ½ years, he will set himself up as God to be worshipped (2 Thessalonians 2:4) which is "the abomination of desolation" described in Matthew 24:15. Do you see how Old Testament prophecies come together with the words of Jesus (Matthew 24), Paul (2 Thessalonians), and John (Revelation)? Does the pieces of the puzzles encourage you to study Revelation?

3) How do the two witnesses of Revelation 11 fit into the overall plan of God?

4) Why is it that no prophecy, no matter how valid and true it is, will sway those who are evil or entrenched in their own ways?

5) Should every Christian expect to be persecuted? Should every Christian expect to be a witness?

6) How does the certainty of the coming of God's kingdom shape the way we live now?

7) How is God's faithfulness shown in both mercy and wrath? Are these contradictory?

8) What is something that you learned from our study on Revelation 11?  
What are some applications for us from Revelation 11?

9) In light of the urgency we have been talking about as we study Revelation, who do you need to speak to about the Gospel?
