On Sunday, the ORANGE Team met at 1:00 and took friendship bread (they made) and visited houses on Highland Ave. They gave out the bread, did a survey, and prayed with lots of folks. On Monday, the RED Team went to Paint Lick Elementary to weed-eat and clean up the front of the school. They were very happy to have that cleaned up. Those are just a couple of examples of what the teams did this week.

The GREEN Team did a cookout for Lancaster Elementary for their open house. We have had some folks bring their kids to KidZrock after being invited by the GREEN Team that night. They plan on setting up at Lancaster Elementary's trunk or treat on Fri. Oct. 26th. They have also prepared popcorn packets inviting people to "pop" in for a visit at LBC. They plan on distributing them at the trunk or treat and door to door in some of their neighborhoods. The Red team is going to help Paint Lick Elementary with their Fall Festival on Oct. 25th. They were going to serve food during the food pantry distribution last week but got rained out. The WHITE Team is going to help with a Celebration of Family event at Lancaster Housing Authority on Oct. 16th from 2:00-5:00 PM. They are also meeting on Oct. 15th to put together bags of candy to do some reverse trick or treat (we take candy to houses and invite them to church) in some of our neighborhoods.

These are just a few of the initiatives our teams are working on to show the love of Christ to our community. It is very exciting to see God answer our prayers for laborers and to see so many involved in these outreach ministries. We can be sure that God will bless our efforts as we labor in the harvest.
