### Revelation 14

**Opening Discussion Question:** What do you think about when you see the number 666 show up on your total or in other areas of life?

**Read Revelation 14:1-20**

**Review Sermon Outline:**

- 1) Why is Christianity a faith that sings (throughout Scripture)?  
What songs are most meaningful for your faith?
  
- 2) Many believe that in the end everyone will go to heaven. How does this passage specify something very different?
  
- 3) What character qualities does Revelation 14:4-5 indicate should be expected in the lives of genuine Christians. (Consider 2 Corinthians 11:2)
  
- 4) The pagan worship and immorality of John's day seems to parallel much of the worldliness that Christians wrestle with today. What thoughts do you have about those who call themselves Christians and attend church but often immerse themselves in selfish and worldly pleasures?
  
- 5) Read Matthew 26:39 and Revelation 14:9-10. How does Jesus' work relate to the wrath of God?

6) How/why would it be called a blessing for those who die in the Lord? What does “rest from their labors” refer?

7) The eternal rewards and punishments of 14:6-13 will occur at the final harvest or last judgment. What is the difference between the harvest of grain (14-16) and the harvest of grapes (17-20)? What is God’s *lex talionis* (law of retribution)?

8) What questions do you still have regarding Revelation 14? What are some applications for us from Revelation 14?

9) Whom has God place in your life with whom you need to plead to flee the wrath & judgment of God?
