### Praying for the Harvest

Todd Gray is the Team Leader for Evangelism and Church Planting at the Kentucky Baptist Convention. He has been super encouraging in the area of evangelism and encouraging pastors/church members to share their faith. He called me last week out of the blue just to talk about how things were going. I was able to share with him some of the things that our GROW teams were doing. He said that when you labor you should expect to see a harvest. After he prayed for me, he asked me to send him a number of salvation/baptisms I would like the Lord to bless us with this year at LBC. After the conversation I began to think about that number. I pray for the harvest and for laborers but I don't often ask God for a particular number of souls to be saved. What number would you say? How many should we ask God to save this year?

The other thing I have been thinking a lot about lately is just being thankful. I have so much to be thankful for. Maybe when you go through a crisis you realize how thankful you should be. I've been trying to be more consistent in writing notes of thanks this year. I regularly think about people who are serving, sacrificing, encouraging, and using their gifts and abilities to show the love of Christ. As your pastor, I want to be faithful in both thanking and encouraging you. I want to encourage you to regularly take a few minutes to thank and encourage others. Maybe you can write them a handwritten note, send them a text, call them, or even send them an email of thanks.

Who can you thank and encourage today?

- How about your Sunday School Teacher who studies every week to divide the word to your class?
- How about your parents who sacrifice to provide for your needs?
- How about the folks who are watching the Nursery or teaching Children's Church?
- How about the person who regularly prays for you?
- How about the person who has invested the most in you spiritually?
- How about somebody who encouragers you regularly?
- How about someone who you see serving others with joy in their heart?
- How about a spouse who is giving of him or herself to minister and serve his or her spouse?
- How about someone who helps with the sound or computer equipment or plays an instrument or sings in the choir?
- How about somebody who helps count the offerings at the end of church or who prays during our services?
- How about those hardworking KidZRock workers who come and pour into children each week?
