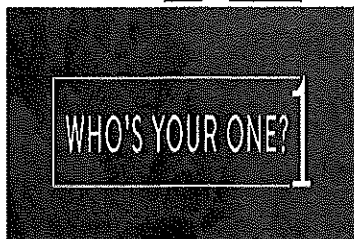

From Your Pastor: ON MISSION: Always & Everywhere

On Wednesday, we (Jeff Moss, April Heatherton, and myself) will be leaving for India. I've never been to that area and am starting to get a little anxious. I know Philippians 4 tells us to "be anxious for nothing" so I am trying to replace my anxieties with prayer and trust. We have a busy week scheduled. We will be going to an orphanage, doing outreach at a leper's colony and in the forest area, sharing at a church on Sunday, and doing Pastor training during the week. I am looking forward to instructing and encouraging about 30 pastors in the area. We are excited to be able to give each Pastor 5 Bibles (in their language) to take back with them. This will be a very big blessing to each of the pastors and we are so thankful for your generosity in providing the Bibles.

As I mentioned on Sunday, I am convinced that we don't have to go on a mission trip to live on mission for Jesus. There are so many opportunities all around us to show love, minister kindness, and share the good news of the Gospel. Going on a mission trip often reminds us that we didn't have to go around the world to find people with needs and people who are in need of a relationship with Jesus Christ. There are people we work with, go to school with, and see regularly that need to hear the gospel. I really want to make "On Mission: Always and everywhere" our theme this year.

If we live on mission, we will constantly be looking for opportunities to connect with people, meet needs, sow gospel seeds, and have gospel conversations. People need the Lord. I have found very few who are opposed to us sharing the good news with them. As a matter of fact, most people are surprised that Christians don't talk to them more about a relationship with Jesus.

Hopefully our study of Revelation has reminded us that the Lord is coming back and that many are not ready for His return. Many are lost in their sin and will stand before His great white throne of judgement one day and be condemned to hell because of their sin. Hell is a real place of eternal damnation, separation from God, darkness, and fire. If somebody was in a house that was on fire we would do all that we could to rescue them. If we know that people are going to hell apart from a relationship with Jesus, we should do all we can to rescue them. We have been rescued by Jesus, who loved us enough to die for our sins. Because of the grace of God we are compelled to go tell the good news.

I asked everybody to identify one person you can pray for and seek to win to Christ this year. In a couple weeks I am going to ask "Who is your one?" I hope you will pick somebody and be faithful to pray and evangelize this year. It surely isn't too much to ask all of us to seek to bring one person to Jesus in 2019. So, "Who is your one?" Start praying for them and asking the Lord to open their eyes and heart to Jesus. I want to join you in praying for them. May God bring the harvest!
