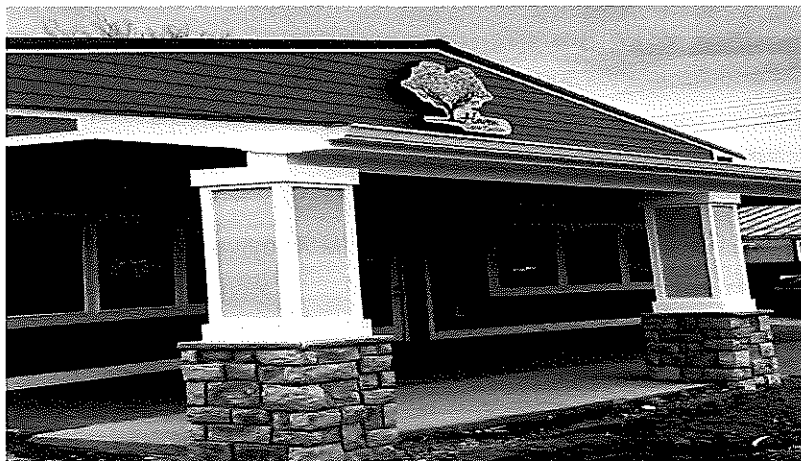

Let's Keep Standing for Life



Last week I wrote about protecting the lives of the unborn. After writing that article we heard the Virginia Governor Ralph Northam speak about the mother and doctor discussing the fate of a newborn baby (which is infanticide). Many were alarmed at the Governor's casual talk about a baby's life. It is sad how divisive this issue is in America. I was glad to hear President Trump stand up for the unborn in his State of the Union address on Tuesday evening. Specifically, President Trump said, "Let us work together to build a culture that cherishes innocent life. And let us reaffirm a fundamental truth: all children - born and unborn - are made in the holy image of God." Unfortunately, there was a group who did not stand, applaud, or agree with that assessment.

On Friday, I stopped by Haven Care Center (pregnancy resource center) in Danville to pick up the baby bottles that we fill with change every year. I was so excited to see their new facility (464 S. 4<sup>th</sup> Street). They now have accessibility, adequate parking, rooms for counseling and even Bible studies. They have a room with an ultrasound where a mother can see her baby's heartbeat. They also have room to store baby clothes, diapers, and accessories that are donated to them. As we think about the cultural debate going on over the protection of the unborn, I was so blessed to see this facility. I want us to consider more ways to support this center as they seek to help pregnant mothers see real alternatives (like adoption) to abortion. Will you fill a bottle this year? Will you consider how you can take another step in the battle to defend the unborn?

Finally, whatever political party you may identify with, I challenge you to let your voice be heard in regards to protecting innocent lives. If you are a Christian Democrat, I think you need to let your pro-life convictions be heard. It doesn't matter what party we may identify with, as Christians, we should take steps to defend the helpless because Scripture calls us to take those steps.
