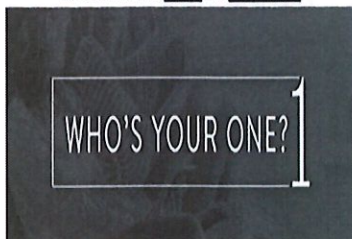

From Your Pastor: *Fasting, Witnessing & Watching*

And when you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces that their fasting may be seen by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. **Matthew 6:16**

Sunday we looked at Jesus' instructions about fasting. I want to invite you to join me in prayer and fasting for our church. I would like for us to fast for 40 days leading up to Easter. I have a sign-up sheet starting on Wed. March 6th through Sat. April 20th. Please consider signing up for at least one day (there is an accompanying prayer guide for each day). I also want to invite you to join me in prayer and fasting every Wednesday from March 6th through Easter. I most often start my fast on the evening meal of one day and continue through breakfast and lunch on the next day. So, I will start my fast on Tuesday at dinner time and end my fast before or after church on Wednesday evening. You are welcome to fast a meal, a day or whatever works best for you.

As I mentioned last week, I would love for you to give me a name of your "Who's Your One?" that you are praying for this year to get saved. As Southern Baptist, many churches are participating in the Who's Your One campaign in order to be more intentional in praying and sharing the Gospel with the lost this year. Again, I will be glad to visit your person (with or without you) and would love to pray for them. I would include them in the focus of your fasting and ask the Lord to save them. If your one gets saved, please let me know. I want to celebrate with you! I really think we can see 26 saved and baptized this year. I'm praying, fasting, and sharing with that goal.

This week, I was happy to see that the United Methodist Church chose to uphold biblical standards of sexual morality and not normalize homosexuality and the ordination of gay bishops. For 2,000 years the church has defined marriage exclusively as the union of a man and a woman. The Bible has not changed even though our culture has changed dramatically. It was an answer to prayer that the United Methodist Church said no to the sexual revolution that is occurring at an alarming rate and said yes to Biblical authority. It will be harder and harder to stand for biblical morality but Jesus never said it would be easy. If a church can't stand on the clear teachings of the Bible, they really shouldn't be called a church or a Christian denomination. We can be thankful for their actions this week!

Finally, our Sunday School lesson this past Sunday was about detecting false teachers in the church. There are lots of false teachings on the airwaves and from the pulpits in our land. I want to encourage you to come out this Sunday evening (March 3rd) and next (March 10th) at 5:30PM to watch and discuss "American Gospel: Christ Alone" documentary. This is a powerful movie about many of the false teachings of our day (like the "Word of Faith" and the Prosperity gospel). It has never been more important for Christians to have a discerning mind when it comes to "religious" teachings today. I hope you will make plans to join us for this movie and discussion.
