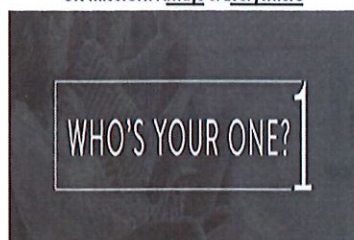

### From Your Pastor: *Adoration*

O God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water. **Psalm 63:1**

Sunday I will be introducing a new sermon series called "A Beautifully Adorned Bride: Becoming a Healthy Disciple while waiting for our Lord." The theme verse for this series is Revelation 19:7, "Let us rejoice and exult and give Him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His Bride has made herself ready." We know our Lord is coming back for His bride (the Church) and we want to be beautiful in His sight. Now, we know we have no righteousness of our own but are clothed in the righteousness of Christ (through faith in Jesus).

The three major themes of this series are: adoration, adornment, and anticipation. We will kickoff the series this Sunday by looking at "Adoration: Getting to know the One who loves us!" I want us to fall in love with our Lord Jesus because He is the One who loves us with a sacrificial, unconditional, and eternal love. I think that as we grow in our adoration for Jesus, we will be passionate about living our lives in a manner that is pleasing to Him. I also think that as we grow in our adoration of Jesus, we will be compelled to speak more about the One we love and share Him with others. We talk about things that mean the most to us. Sadly, I don't think many Christians think about or talk about our Lord nearly enough.

The majority of this series will be adorning ourselves with "the righteous deeds of the saints" (which comes from Revelation 19:8. Under "Adornment" we will consider our baptism, commitment to the church, discipleship, evangelism, prayer and fasting, giving, missions, repentance, love of Scripture, service, and our worship. I pray that we will be edified as we study and explore each of these topics.

We will conclude with anticipation. I think we should live with anticipation and urgency as we look forward to the coming of our Lord. There are so many around us (Garrard County) and around the world who are not ready for the Lord's return. The lostness of the world is great. We must be living with Gospel urgency. I am very excited about this series and even feel like I might need to make this into a book or manual for new believers. I would appreciate your prayers as we journey through this series. May God use this to make us into a beautiful bride for His Son.

As I mentioned in previous letters and sermons, I would love to invite you to join me in special times of prayer and fasting now through Easter (Apr. 21<sup>st</sup>). We have sign-ups for every day (except Sunday's) through Apr. 20<sup>th</sup>. I am also inviting you to join me in fasting each Wednesday. If another day works better, please join us. Let's ask God to draw us near to Him and draw others to Himself. Let us come in dependence upon Him to move in and through our church for His glory!
